

Annual

Performed per manufacturer recommendations.

Inspection and preventive maintenance services may include:

- Onsite or in-shop servicing
- Complete check of controls
- Examination of emergency or backup capabilities
- Inspection of chains and cables for wear and improper adjustment
- Inspection of hydraulic hoses for wear and leaks
- Lubrication of specified moving parts
- Replacement of filter elements at manufacturer-required intervals
- Check of hydraulic oil, engine oil and coolant
- Structural check of fasteners, pins, shafts and locking devices
- Check of instruction placards, warnings and control markings
- Routine adjustments
- Check of factory recalls and service bulletins
- Report of all malfunctions and a cost estimate for repairs
- Service record retention for a minimum of three years


